

Extract from the provision of the International Solidarity Contest called «Na Odnii Khvyli» («On the Same Wave»)

1. The International Solidarity Contest «Na Odnii Khvyli» will be held from May till November 2020 within the framework of the International Decade for the Rapprochement of Cultures (2013-2022) under the resolution of the United Nations.

2. The aim of the Contest is to develop communicative skills of children and teenagers, to gain the system of the national and common to mankind cultural values; to bring up tolerant attitude to other nationalities, cultures and traditions; to bring up high citizen consciousness; to foster national and patriotic development, identification with the state, its history and culture.

3. The organizers of the contest are National Library of Ukraine for Children, (onward NLU for Children), National Section of the International Board on Books for

Young People (IBBY) and Ukrainian Association of the Workers of the Specialized Libraries for Children (onward – Association)

4. Children from Ukraine, neighboring countries and EU will take part in the Contest. They are divided into three age categories:

Readers – pupils of the 1-4 forms; Readers – pupils of the 5-8 forms;

Readers – pupils of the 3-8 forms,

Readers – pupils of the 9-11 forms.

5. Individual and corporate works for the contest will be accepted in two nominations:

- Children's book overcomes borders
- Children are for Peace!

6. The contest will be held from 16th May (Europe Day) till 16th of November 2020 (International Day for Tolerance) in three rounds:

The first – from 16th May till 24th August on the local level;

The second – from 25th August till 30th September on the region level (for Ukraine), on the state level (for neighboring countries and the EU);

The third – from 01st October till 16th November, as a summary.

7. The participants of the Contest in every nomination and age category are preparing a poster/painting with the slogan that must be well decorated and must respond with its content and genre to the topic of an author's vision of the future of the country and the peace in the world.

8. The poster/image must be made on the paper A3 as for the participants of the Contest from Ukraine or digitalized and sent in digital format (only for the participants from abroad if they can't send the original work by post)

9. The works should be sent with the short information about the author: name, surname, and date of birth, domestic address, e-mail address, phone number; for the teamwork add the name and surname of the head of the art club.

10. The main organizational committee and the main jury are established for the preparation and holding the Contest.

11. For the first and second rounds of the Contest in Ukrainian regions, neighborhood countries and EU are created local organizational committees and juries that accomplish protocols signed by the head, secretary and members of the jury specifying the total amount of participants and the winners,.

12. The local juries of the Contest make a summary and indicate one winner in every nomination, age category among individual and team participants till 30th September, 2020; it means 6 winners from the region and every country-participant.

13. Competition winning works of the second round from Ukraine, neighboring countries and EU must be sent with protocols to the main organizational committee (03190, Ukraine Kyiv 60, Yanusha Korchaka National Library of Ukraine for Children) not later than 02 October 2020. The works, sent after this date won't be taken into account.

14. The digitalized competitive works of the second round from the neighboring countries and EU must be sent in an e-mail to the main organizational committee library@chl.kiev.ua (t.m.kuzilova@gmail.com) till 02 October 2020.

15. For the winners of the Contest in every nomination and age category among individual and team works are established the first, the second and the third places.

16. The main jury evaluates the works that came from local juries and determines the winners till 30th September.

17. Posters/images sent for the Contest will not be returned to the authors, but will be stored in NLU for Children and can be used for the further work with authors' permissions.

18. Following the results of the Contest will be made an Almanac of the works of art.

19. Posters/images –winners will be presented as a part of an international exhibition at the Embassies of the countries-participants.
